- **Theme:** God's sovereignty can be an <u>encouragement</u> for the people of God.
 - It is the <u>only</u> reason we can pursue "self-denial."
 - It is the <u>only</u> reason we can have assurance of salvation.

When we become followers of Jesus, we quickly realize that...

- · We are WEAK and SMALL.
 - Compared to God's strength and greatness.
 - Compared to the way we ought to be.
- God is WORKING in us.
 - Empowering us.
 - To get us where we should be!


Result: There is GROWTH!



God's <u>sovereignty</u> and Human responsibility WORKING TOGETHER:

- They GUARANTEE that self-denial will be present (in increasing measure) in the life of <u>every</u> genuine follower of Jesus.
- They even guarantee that this guarantee is guaranteed! (etc.)





We can rest (and grow stronger) in God's promises



 When we fail, we can look to Scripture for encouragement and guidance.
 Then, we can get up and start again.

God began our salvation... and he will finish it! **GUARANTEED!**

.. being confident of this, that <u>he who</u>
<u>began a good work in you</u> will carry it on to
completion until the day of Christ Jesus.

Philip. 1:6 (NIV)

... Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, ...

Hebrews 12:2 (NIV)

He will <u>enable</u> our growth, so we can fulfill our *obligation* to grow!

<u>OBLIGATION</u>: But <u>grow</u> in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

2 Peter 3:18a (NET)

ENABLED: [Jesus Christ] the Head, from whom the whole body, supported and held together by its ligaments and sinews, grows as God causes it to grow.

Col. 2:19 (NIV)

God will increase our *power* and our *willingness* to grow.

... continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling,

for *it is God who works in you* to **will** and to **act** according to his good purpose.

Philip. 2:12b-13 (NIV)

... the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world.

1 John 4:4b (NET)



YES!! Power from God!! ;

For God did not give us a spirit of timidity, but a *spirit of power*, of love and of self-discipline.

2 Tim. 1:7 (NIV)

But we need to remember our <u>dependency</u> on him.

I can do all things <u>through him who</u> strengthens me.

Philip. 4:13 (ESV)

YOUR JOB: Focus on the "human responsibility" part of GROWING

- Willingly <u>do</u> what is necessary to make spiritual growth happen.
 - GROW in your <u>understanding</u> of Scripture, so that you can discern truth from error.
 - PRAY for a <u>willingness to submit</u> to Scripture, so that it will change your values and actions.

Remember that self-denial is <u>every</u> person's DUTY.

- Self-denial is a **DUTY** (moral obligation) for *all* people, whether saved or not.
- Only with the Spirit of God in us, can it become our DESIRE.
 - When the desire and the actions are <u>both</u> present, it is <u>evidence</u> of salvation.

Don't be surprised when people oppose it!

- THE WORLD WILL TELL US:
 - We <u>deserve</u> lasting happiness and fulfillment; we <u>deserve</u> to be pampered.
- THE WORLD LIES TO US!
 - It can't give what it promises.
 - We <u>don't deserve</u> these things anyway, because each of us has rebelled against <u>God</u>, the <u>source</u> of all life, peace and happiness.

Don't pretend it will be easy!

(You must rely on GOD's power.)

- ABILITY? You CAN'T do it,*
 unless the power of God is in you.
- DESIRE? <u>You won't WAN'T do it</u>,* <u>unless</u> the power of God is in you.

*(the $\underline{\textit{genuine}}$ type of "self-denial")

- It WON'T always be <u>easy</u> and <u>fun</u>.
- · But it WILL always be worth the effort!


If you think it's going to be easy


You're going to be disillusioned.


But <u>they</u> said it would be FUN...

 Our spirit <u>desires</u> self-denial, but our flesh <u>hates</u> it.











Pay attention to the Spirit's prompting

- · Genuine followers of Jesus want selfdenial!
- It's one of the desires that the Spirit of God puts in you, when you begin to follow Jesus!



- · A follower of Jesus would not be comfortable with any other perspective!
 - WHY? Because self-denial is part of the definition - what it means to "follow" Jesus!

It's the FAKES who won't succeed!

- · They may make excuses.
 - "It isn't needed!" OR "It's a lofty, unattainable goal (so it's a waste of time to try)."
- · They may admit the need & still not do it.
 - "I know I should do it, but..."
- · They may oppose it.
 - "Jesus wants you to feel good about yourself."

It's the FAKES who won't succeed!

- · Whatever their excuse or claim...
 - They just won't do those things that are a part of "following Jesus."
 - Instead, their way of life will be characterized by following the impulses of the flesh (Those impulses may involve opposing self denial, or counterfeiting it).

YOUR MISSION #1

- PRAY FOR THE FAKES those who oppose self-denial and those who are counterfeits.
 - Maybe God will someday begin a work of grace in their hearts!
- .. in the hope that God will grant them repentance leading them to a knowledge of the truth, ...

YOUR MISSION #2

ENCOURAGE EACH OTHER

- God never intended us to grow "alone." We are part of a community, a "body."

And in him you too are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit.

YOUR MISSION #3

REJOICE IN SOVEREIGNTY

- God is doing something for us that we don't deserve!
- He is saving us... and his work in us is proof of our salvation!
