

• God has given YOU a new way to live.


So I say, *live by the Spirit*, and you will not gratify the desires of the sinful nature.




 Holiness and righteousness is to characterize YOUR life.


[You were taught] ... to put on the new self, <u>created to be like God</u> in true righteousness and holiness.















































Don't blame GOD for the consequences of your sin! At the marriage: I don't care what God says... I'll marry who I want!! Why did God let my marriage fail??

DISCLAIMER #1 – The "marriage" example

- We used this example because so many young people are destroying their lives in this way.
- 2) In countries where people don't get to <u>choose</u> their marriage partner, this example might not apply.

DISCLAIMER #2 – Other examples could be used

1) There are <u>many other ways</u> you can become unequally yoked.

Through careers, sports, hobbies, entertainment, unsaved friends, organizations, "good causes"...

 Any time they pull you away from God's calling for you, don't become yoked to them!

Even if they are fun, friendly, pleasant, etc.



The following suggestions are for a "worst case scenario" – but the basic principles will apply in other situations.

There is "HOPE among the ashes."

 If you're a genuine follower of Jesus, God will use your sin to accomplish good in your life.

And we know that God causes all things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to His purpose.

Romans 8:28 (NASB)

You may have brought upon yourself <u>unnecessary pain</u>. Even so, you *will* reach that that good!

"WHAT SHOULD I DO?"

 HUMBLE yourself and <u>TRUST</u> God to fulfill his promise (even through the pain, if pain occurs).

Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up.

James 4:10 (NIV)

2. Have a "FUTURE FOCUS." The day is coming in which your pain and sorrow will be gone.

He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away.

Rev. 21:4 (NIV)

We don't like to have such a sad conclusion; BUT AS ALREADY STATED... Some CONSEQUENCES of our choices are inescapable.

THOSE WHO ARE GENUINE...

- THEY WILL LEARN:
 - 1) The wisdom of NOT choosing to be unequally yoked.
 - 2) To <u>accept</u> what God says about "separation" (rather than <u>opposing</u> it).
- THEY WILL CHOOSE:
 - to live a way that <u>demonstrates</u> their salvation.
- GOD WILL MAKE SURE THIS HAPPENS!
 - ... it is <u>God who works in you</u> to will and to act according to his good purpose.

YOUR MISSION

BE "YOKED"... but in the <u>right</u> way!

Do not be yoked together with unbelievers.

2 Cor. 6:14a (NIV)

NOT YOKED the wrong way!

 <u>WHY</u> would <u>you</u> <u>HOW</u> could <u>you</u> ... want to see how close you can get to **DEATH**?

God has YOKED you to a <u>new family</u> – the "family of believers."

(Galatians 6:10)

- Get to know them. <u>They</u> are to be your closest associates.
- Build each other up. Both you and they need it!

Even the apostle Paul needed it!

For I long to see you, that I may impart to you some spiritual gift to strengthen you—that is, that we may be <u>mutually encouraged</u> by each other's faith, both yours and mine.
