(Make sure while you can!)

Examine yourselves, to see whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves.

Or do you not realize this about yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you?

—unless indeed you fail to meet the test!

(2 Corinthians 13:5, ESV)

Their *ABSENCE* is a good indicator that you do <u>not</u> know God...



But their PRESENCE does not <u>guarantee</u> salvation, for an <u>UNSAVED</u> person can do it!


This might include...

Followers of these "non-religious" activities go through the same motions as do followers of the "religious" ones.


- Same zeal and devotion!

For instance...




The <u>atheists</u> have their own kind of religious activities – expressions of "blind faith"!

No!
And some might prove you aren't!

Well...

How about the ABSENCE of religious activities?



Today, many people in churches downplay religious activities.

But studies have shown that
"spirituality" WITHOUT some type of
religious activities tends to result in
unstable people.

JESUS, NOT
RELIGION!!

The issue isn't

"Christ vs. Religion" (though they are different).

but

"What does the Bible say?"


- Certain activities are required by God. (Examples: Worship, prayer, learning God's Word, baptism, the Lord's Supper, etc.)
- Genuine Christians will <u>want</u> to do what God requires them to do!
- Unfortunately... fakes can do them too.

Remember Jesus' "friends," the Pharisees?

A perfect example of:

"... having a form of godliness but denying its power."

Matthew 23:5a, 23b, 23:25b, 27b-28 (NIV)

Everything they do is done for men to see...

You give a tenth of your spices--mint, dill and cummin. But you have neglected the more important matters of the law--justice, mercy and faithfulness.

You clean the outside of the cup and dish, but inside they are full of greed and self-indulgence.

You are like whitewashed tombs, which look beautiful on the outside but on the inside are full of dead men's bones and everything unclean. In the same way, on the outside you appear to people as righteous but on the inside you are full of hypocrisy and wickedness.

YOUR MISSION

- Know the difference between "following Jesus" and "doing religion." They are NOT the same!
- Follow Jesus and do what he says (even if it includes "religious" things).

YOUR MISSION ...

- · Don't be afraid to have a "form of godliness" - religious activity - but make sure it reflects what is in your heart!
- · Don't rely on religion for salvation, because it doesn't work (as the Pharisees now know).
