




TODAY'S TOPIC:

Conviction of sin

(includes confessing it to those we've sinned against)

- All people have an awareness of their sin (unless their consciences have become seared).
- Some become convicted with a strong awareness of their guilt.
- But does that *prove* they are followers of Jesus?



Not referring to what politicians and celebrities often do when they get "caught" in a sin.



- "I'm so terribly sorry. It's all my fault. I failed the public trust. ..."
- P.S. "Vote for me next year!"

(Some politicians might be a little more *genuine* than this.)

Not referring to what many church-goers do...

ON THE OUTSIDE (WHEN CAUGHT):

"I'm so terribly sorry ... I am such a sinner... Please forgive me!"



BUT ON THE INSIDE:

"I'm so glad I'm a Christian. Now I can sin all I want and still get to heaven!

God has to forgive

= a bunch of theatrics. (hypocrisy, putting on a mask, etc.)

By the way, such a lifestyle <u>cannot</u> belong to a genuine follower of Jesus! It's just plain impossible!

1 John 3:9 (NIV)
No one who is born
of God will continue to
sin, because God's
seed remains in him;
he cannot go on
sinning, because he
has been born of God.





The issue:

CAN A PERSON HAVE <u>GENUINE</u> CONVICTION ABOUT SIN AND STILL BE UNSAVED?

Let's look at some Bible examples.

Pharaoh (on several occasions)


Exodus 9:27-28, 34-35 (NET)

So Pharaoh sent and summoned Moses and Aaron and said to them, "I have sinned this time! The Lord is righteous, and I and my people are guilty. Pray to the Lord, for the mighty thunderings and hail are too much! I will release you and you will stay no longer."

When Pharaoh saw that the rain and hail and thunder ceased, he sinned again: both he and his servants hardened their hearts. So Pharaoh's heart remained hard, and he did not release the Israelites, as the Lord had predicted through Moses.



King Saul – The "theme" of his life.




But every now and then...

1 Samuel 24:16b-17 (NET)

... Saul wept loudly.

"You are more innocent than I, for you have treated me well, even though I have tried to harm you!



Matthew 27:3-5 (NET)

Now when Judas, who had betrayed him, saw that Jesus had been condemned, he regretted what he had done and returned the thirty silver coins to the chief priests and the elders, saying, "I have sinned by betraying innocent blood!"

But they said, "What is that to us? You take care of it yourself!"

So Judas threw the silver coins into the temple and left. Then he went out and hanged himself.

Judas – remorse, but not repentance; sorrow, but not change.



Conviction of sin normally comes with an awareness of deserved judgment (such as death, or the Lake of Fire).

Romans 1:32 (NET)

... they fully know God's righteous decree that those who practice such things deserve to die, ...

But "Having a fear of hell" is NOT the same as "Being saved"!

Acts 24:25 (NET)

While Paul was discussing righteousness, self-control, and the coming judgment, Felix became frightened and said, "Go away for now, and when I have an opportunity, I will send for you."





YOUR MISSION... Be aware of these things:

- You <u>need</u> to be convicted when you sin. (Pray that it happens. If it doesn't happen, it means your conscience has been seared; and you will die in your sin.)
- Genuine followers of Jesus will want to be convicted when they sin, so they can repent of it.

YOUR MISSION...

 DON'T RELY ON CONVICTION AS EVIDENCE OF SALVATION... because it isn't evidence!
