
Assurance of Salvation Part 46 Faith (#9)











Using the Scriptures...

- The Spirit teaches us...
 - ... and we are willing to *learn*.
- · The Spirit directs us...
 - ... and we are willing to obey.

I am the Lord your God, who <u>teaches</u> you what is best for you, who <u>directs</u> you in the way you should go.

THE FIRST STEP: TEACHING / LEARNING The Holy Spirit uses the Scriptures to

- The Holy Spirit uses the Scriptures to teach and convince us about:
 - The BAD NEWS: Our sin and guilt.
 - The GOOD NEWS: Jesus' sacrifice and God's offer.
- ALWAYS BOTH.

(The Spirit never gives us a HALF-truth.)



THE BAD NEWS: OUR HOPELESS CONDITION

- We <u>don't like</u> to hear it, because it sounds so "negative."
- But it's TRUTHFUL, <u>and is needed</u> for salvation.
- In the Bible we discover...



We are hopelessly **SINFUL**

- · We are rebels, fighting against God.
- We have offended the holy and righteous God.
- We have turned away from God and have rejected his holy law.

About GOD:

Your eyes are too pure to look on evil; you cannot tolerate wrong.

(Habakkuk 1:13a NIV)

About US:

As it is written,

"There is no one righteous; no, not one. There is no one who understands. There is no one who seeks after God.

They have all turned aside.

They have together become unprofitable.

There is no one who does good, no, not, so much as one."

(Romans 3:10-12 WEB)

We are hopelessly **GUILTY**

- WE deserve ONLY judgment no mercy or pity.
- · God is RIGHT to give us this judgment.

The person who sins will be the one who dies.

(Ezekiel 18:4b NLT)

For the wages of sin is death, ...

(Romans 6:23a NLT)

We have **NO MERIT** to cling to

· We have NOTHING we can cling to, which can earn God's favor.

I know that nothing good lives in me, that is, in my sinful nature.

For I have the desire to do what is good, but I cannot carry it out.

Romans 7:18 (NIV)

· Even after we are saved, we have NOTHING to boast about (in salvation),

** except for GOD. **

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith ... not by works, so that no one can boast.

(Ephes. 2:8-9 NIV)

Therefore, as it is written: "Let him who boasts boast in the Lord."

We have **NO HOPE** to cling to

- · There is NOTHING we can do to get out of this judgment.
 - Eternally without hope and utterly condemned.

Like the rest, we were by nature objects of wrath. ... without hope and without God in the world.

(Ephes. 2:3b, 12b NIV)

SINFUL, GUILTY, NO MERIT



☆ HOPELESS ☆



... those who are not holy will not see the Lord.

(Hebrews 12:14b NLT)

UNTIL ... WE ... DISCOVER...

But God is so rich in mercy, ...

(Ephes. 2:4b NLT)

THE GOOD NEWS: **OUR HOPE**

- · We like to hear this part, because it sounds "positive."
- · But it has no saving value, until we've accepted the BAD news.

 In the Bible we discover...



Our **SUBSTITUTE**

- God gave <u>his</u> Son to bear <u>our</u> punishment.
 - So he wouldn't have to cast us from his presence.

For God so loved the world that he *gave* his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life.

.. the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord.

(Romans 6:23b NLT)

God's JUSTICE MAINTAINED

- Through Jesus, God can have <u>mercy</u> yet still maintain justice.
 - God's Law, which <u>demands</u> death, is vindicated.
 - ... he did it* to demonstrate his justice at the present time, so as to be just and the one who justifies those who have faith in Jesus.

(Romans 3:26 NIV)

* (God presented Christ as a sacrifice of atonement.)

Our **OPPORTUNITY**

- We are <u>invited</u> to return to God for mercy!
 - We are promised that if we come, we will not be turned away!

'God, have mercy on me, a sinner.'

(Luke 18:13b NIV

I will <u>never turn away</u> anyone who comes to me.

John 6:37 (GW)

Our **OBLIGATION**

- God also commands us to come.
 - If we refuse to do so, our sin becomes even greater.
 - .. he <u>commands</u> all people everywhere to repent.

(Acts 17:30b NIV)

They perish because they refused to love the truth and so be saved.

(2 Thes. 2:10b NIV)

On what basis can we have salvation?

Because of anything we did? NO!

He saved us, not because of the good things we did, but <u>because of his</u> mercy.

He washed away our sins and gave us a new life through the Holy Spirit.

Titus 3:5 (NLT)

- It's based simply on God's PROMISE!
- .. the hope of eternal life, which God, who does not lie, *promised* before the beginning of time, ...

Titus 1:2 (NIV)

And this is what he *promised* us--even eternal life.

1 John 2:25 (NIV)

Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who *promised* is faithful.

Hebrews 10:23 (NIV)

Have **YOU** taken this <u>FIRST</u> STEP?

- You have strayed into sin. Are you willing to return to obedience?
- Jesus says, "Come, follow me." Will you?
- Are you willing to TRUST God in all matters?



If so, then take the <u>SECOND</u> STEP!

- Once the Holy Spirit uses the Word of God to <u>teach</u> us these things...
- He continues, by using the Word of God to accomplish the "<u>action</u>" part in our lives.

THE SECOND STEP: DIRECTING / OBEYING

- The Holy Spirit makes us willing to respond rightly to the facts.
- The Holy Spirit uses the Scriptures to <u>guide us</u> in repentance, trust and obedience.
