"He said so... Let's give him 'the benefit of the doubt.' "

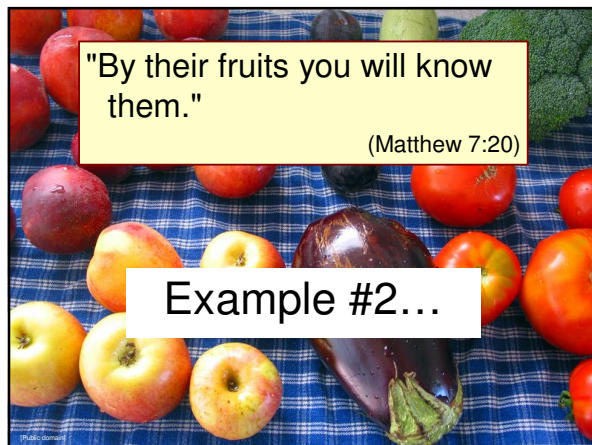
"Who am I to judge?"
