




There are <u>so many</u> ways the devil can attack you.

to <u>the only God our Savior</u> be glory, majesty, power and authority, ...


Jude 1:24-25a (NIV)

But there is <u>also</u> a RESPONSIBILITY part that WE must do.
























THE ONLY ISSUE that remains: How willing are YOU to do the growing? Your <u>actions</u> and <u>choices</u> (not your words and claims) will demonstrate the answer to this question. NO NO YES YES NO IF you are unwilling to deal with sin:

- - It's because the Spirit of God is not in you.
 - If this characterizes your life, you are not saved.


YES If you are willing to deal with sin:

- It's because the Spirit of God is in you.
- If this characterizes your life, you are saved.

Principle #9:

Don't use "growth" as an excuse for willful sin!

- The devil always tries to distort truth!
- · A spiritually-alive person cannot want to live a spiritually-dead person!



There are:

TWO PRINCIPLES

found in Scripture, regarding OUR response to sin:

- 1. Some Scripture passages teach us: Certain things cannot happen.
- 2. Other Scripture passages teach us: Growth and maturity will occur.

PRINCIPLE #1:

Certain things cannot happen.

(IF you have chosen to follow Jesus.)

 A person cannot <u>deliberately</u> choose to sin, unless he first rejects the Spirit of God (= the Spirit who lives in <u>all</u> of God's people).

No one who is born of God will continue to sin, because God's seed remains in him;

he <u>cannot</u> go on sinning, because he has been born of God.

1 John 3:9 (NIV)

Deliberate, ongoing, willful sin cannot happen.

This principle applies to <u>all</u> sins, but it seems to have a greater focus on the "bigger" sins...

Now that I'm saved, I only murder two people a month! I'm saved, so I only commit sodomy twice a week!

DON'T MAKE EXCUSES

by claiming that you "just haven't yet grown enough" to stop sinning.

This isn't "growth." It is "slavery to sin." (Romans 6)

PRINCIPLE #2:

The focus on growth.

- This focus tends to be on things like:
 - Accidental sins that creep up unexpectedly...
 - ... even though we don't want to do them.
 - Conduct that we don't realize is sin...
 - ... but God will use his Word to open our eyes.
 - Habits that grew for many years before salvation...
 - ... and may take time to completely break.
- It also includes a willingness to <u>admit that those</u> things are sin and to <u>reject them</u>.

GROWTH

Yesterday, I accidently cursed someone.

Once I realized what I had done, I confessed it as sin, and asked for his forgiveness...

... and God's forgiveness.

I was with my friends, and accidently said, "Oh my God," without the proper attitude of honor and respect.

Once I realized what I had done, I told my friends that I had sinned by taking God's name in vain...

... and asked for God's forgiveness.
