# Romans 12:9-21

Most of the verbs and participles are commands (direct or implied), and they are present tense and active.

Command...

DO IT!

Present tense... NOW!

Active...

KEEP ON DOING IT!

You're probably asking... SO WHAT? I DON'T EVEN And here's the answer... **KNOW WHAT A** "PARTICIPLE" IS!

• The things they say must <u>define</u> your life.


PRESENT TENSE = "Now" ACTIVE = "ONGOING"


yes vs. "YES" COMMANDS <u>no</u> • For a "YES" lifestyle – things that must <u>do</u> characterize your life. vs. don't <u>start</u> There are vs. "NO" COMMANDS stop • You must REPLACE the "NO" lifestyle with a "YES" lifestyle. **STOP** doing the one thing and **START** doing the other.


# **SALVATION is FREE** — The only thing we can *earn* is **DEATH**. - God offers us the free gift of LIFE. **GOD GIVES** WE EARN For the <u>wages</u> of sin is **DEATH**, but the free gift of God is ETERNAL LIFE < through Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 6:23 (NLT)
















# • Verse 9b focuses on our <u>attitude</u>. WHERE WE MUST START Hate what is evil; cling to what is good. Romans 12:9b (NIV) • Verse 21 focuses on our <u>actions</u>. WHERE WE MUST FINISH Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good. Romans 12:21 (NIV)





# CLING TO THE GOOD... because it's the GOOD that wins the battle! Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good. Romans 12:21 (NIV) We can do it,\* because JESUS made it possible! (as in 1 Peter 2:24) He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness ... \* (Applies only to followers. Others don't have this power.)

# TO HAVE SINCERE, NON-HYPOCRITICAL LOVE...

- V. 9b We need to develop the right <u>attitude</u>.
- V. 21 This attitude must be transformed into <u>action</u>.

We get from v. 9b to v. 21 by <u>accepting</u> and <u>living by</u> the instructions of v. 10-20.



# In the beginning, there was good.

To recognize it, we (the human race) needed to learn the difference between good and evil. But we chose to learn the wrong way - by doing evil (disobedience), rather than by doing good (obedience). See Genesis 1-3.

Now, evil (rather than good) has become our nature.

# **OUR NATURAL CONDITION**

On the surface, we *can* do good things. But in the heart, evil characterizes our nature ... *according to Jesus* - Luke 11:13.

We are born with an evil, sinful nature.

- On our own, we cannot change Jeremiah 13:23.
- But if we *don't* change, a horrible fate awaits us Isaiah 5:20.
- (See also Romans 7:18; 8:5-8; Job 14:4.)
