




The HOPE that GOD offers us

...so perishes the <u>hope of the</u> <u>godless.*</u>


What he trusts in is fragile; what he relies on is a spider's web.







"Be joyful in hope ..."
Romans 12:12a

We have many reasons to rejoice in our hope! (Here are more examples.)

Those who belong to God have a hope that the world cannot comprehend. Even death itself cannot overpower it.

OUR HOPE IS FROM GOD.

God is the source of our hope.

- Our hope is in God (not in our own efforts) 1 Timothy 4:10; 1 Peter 1:21.
- Our hope comes from the "God of hope," by the Spirit's power - Romans 15:13; and by his grace - 2 Thessalonians 2:16.
- Our hope is centered in Jesus Christ 1 Timothy 1:1; and it is because of his resurrection from the dead 1 Peter 1:3.

God builds up our hope.

- He builds it up by means of his Word Romans 15:4.
- He uses the trials of life to grow our hope Romans 5:3-4.
- The presence of God's love within us gives certainty to our hope Romans 5:5.

MORE ABOUT THIS HOPE:

It effects how we live.

- We can have endurance 1 Thessalonians 1:3.
- We can be bold in telling others about Jesus 2 Corinthians 3:12.
- It's part of the "spiritual armor" we can use to fight the devil 1 Thessalonians 5:8.
- When saved people die, we do not have to grieve in the hopeless way that the unsaved do - 1 Thessalonians 4:13.

Genuine hope is linked to genuine faith (trust).

• Our faith (trust) in God's promises is the basis for having certainty about the things we hope for (i.e., the things we look forward to) - Hebrews 11:1.

There are also many other things we can rejoice in! (Some examples.)

Though this week's focus is on rejoicing in our *hope*, it doesn't hurt to remember that God gives us *many* reasons to rejoice!

- The good news about salvation: Rejoicing when it is preached
 Philippians 1:18; see also Acts 13:48 (response to hearing it).
- The spiritual growth of others: When they are walking in the truth 3 John 1:3-4; obedient to God Romans 16:19; when they are strong (even if we feel weak) 2 Corinthians 13:9.
- Joy during trials and persecution: Because it associates us with Jesus - Acts 5:41; 1 Peter 4:13; since God will reward us -Matthew 5:12; Luke 6:23; when it is for the good of others -Colossians 1:24.
