Don't be "wise-minded" in yourself.

(= With a negative connotation.)

ATTITUDE OF SUPERIORITY AND IMPORTANCE

I DESERVE HONOR AND RESPECT!

THE RELIGIOUS LEADERS IN JESUS' DAY HAD THIS ATTITUDE.

"They do everything to attract people's attention. ...
They love the place of honor at dinners and the front seats in synagogues.
They love to be greeted in the marketplaces and to have people call them Rabbi." *

Matthew 23:5a, 6-7 (GW)

* ("Rabbi" = "Master Teacher")

ATTITUDE OF SUPERIORITY AND IMPORTANCE

And **don't** call anyone on earth your father, because you have only one Father, and he is in heaven.

SELF-SUFFICIENT

I'VE GOT EVERYTHING UNDER CONTROL!

THE LUKEWARM CHURCH HAD THIS ATTITUDE.

"You say, 'I am rich; I have acquired wealth and do not need a thing.' "

PAUL ENCOURAGED A TOTALLY DIFFERENT ATTITUDE.

For I can do everything with the help of Christ who gives me the strength I need.

Philip. 4:13 (NLT)

SELF-SUFFICIENT

~~I'VE GOT EVERYTHING UNDER CONTROL!~~

PAUL TEACHES US (BY HIS OWN EXAMPLE) ...

[Jesus] said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness."

Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me. ... For when I am weak, then I am strong.

(1) Not many of the world's "wise" are saved.

At that time Jesus said, "I praise you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and learned, and revealed them to little children."

Matthew 11:25 (NIV)



[The Corinthians learned this fact]

Not many of you were wise by human standards; not many were influential; not many were of noble birth.

1 Cor. 1:26b (NIV)

(2) Those who are saved will **CHANGE** the focus of their boasting.

Thus says the LORD: "Let not the wise man boast in his wisdom, let not the mighty man boast in his might, let not the rich man boast in his riches, but let him who boasts boast in this, that he understands and knows me, that I am the LORD who practices steadfast love, justice, and righteousness in the earth. For in these things I delight, declares the LORD."

Jeremiah 9:23-24 (ESV)



(3) Comparing yourself to your own standards is NOT wise.

Certainly, when they measure themselves by themselves and compare themselves to themselves, they show how foolish they are.

2 Cor. 10:12b (GW)

Do you see a man wise in his own eyes?
There is more hope for a fool than for him.

Proverbs 26:12 (NASB)



(4) There are 2 types of "wisdom" – but only one type is wise to have!



Do any of you have wisdom and insight?
Show this by living the right way with
the humility that comes from wisdom.

But if you are bitterly jealous and filled
with self-centered ambition, don't brag.
... That kind of wisdom doesn't come
from above. It belongs to this world. It
is self-centered and demonic.

James 3:13-14a, 15 (GW)

(This type of wisdom is wise to have!)



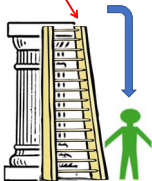
However, the wisdom that comes from above is first of all pure. Then it is

"Do not be conceited." [= a "wise-minded" self-opinion]

Romans 12:16c



THE WORLD'S WISDOM:

- Based on futile, corrupt thinking - Ephesians 4:17-20; Titus 1:15.
- Suppresses its awareness (knowledge) of genuine truth about God - Romans 1:18-23+.
- Considers God's wisdom (which is genuine and based on truth) to be "foolish" - 1 Corinthians 1:21, 25; 2:14.

GENUINE WISDOM:

- Based on what Jesus says - Matthew 7:24-27. (As well as on the rest of the Bible, which Jesus affirmed in chapters 5-7.)
- The contrast between the two types of "wisdom" (genuine vs. the world's) - James 3:13-18.

GENUINE WISDOM, IF ACCEPTED, WILL EFFECT ONE'S CONDUCT.

- It is to influence our interaction with others - Matthew 10:16.
- Parables: The "faithful and wise servant," who willingly fulfils his duties - Matthew 24:45-51; Luke 12:42-46; the "five wise virgins," who plan ahead - Matthew 25:1-13.
- Parable: The "unrighteous steward," who illustrates preparing for the future (though done in the way that an unrighteous person might do so) - Luke 16:8.

BEING "SELF-WISE":

- Using one's self as the basis for evaluating one's self is not wise - 2 Corinthians 10:12!
- Being "wise in one's own estimation" may actually be an expression of ignorance - Romans 11:25 (an example).
- A warning against having a self-exalting, "self-wise" attitude - Romans 12:16c.
- The Corinthians were "wise" in their own eyes, in contrast to Paul - 1 Corinthians 4:10; 10:15; 2 Corinthians 11:19! (In some of these verses, Paul was using sarcasm.)

God's KINDNESS TO THE UNSAVED:

HE MAKES IT POSSIBLE FOR THEM TO HAVE SOME ASPECTS OF GENUINE WISDOM

- There *are* some types of wisdom that God enables the unsaved to have, in spite of their rebellion against God. The book of Proverbs is an example of this type of wisdom.
- Many of the Proverbs are designed to show us how to live better right now, in our day-to-day present life.
- Doing what the book of Proverbs teaches doesn't save a person *eternally*; but it helps restrain sin, and enables people to live a better life in this *present* life.
- Even *without* regard to eternity, God's Word has value! It is quite ironical that even those who *hate* God would have better lives *right now*, if they paid attention to God's instructions about living!
