Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship. Romans 12:1 (NIVI1) When we consider all that chapters 1-11 teach us (= truth, facts): Nothing else makes sense!




(THIS VERSE SAYS SOMETHING SIMILAR...) You do not belong to yourself, for God bought you with a high price. So you must honor God with your body. 1 Cor. 6:19b-20 (NLT) But it actually refers to your whole person! (AS JESUS SAID...) And you must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, all your mind, and all your strength. Mark 12:30 (NLT)

interact! (= Part of the FACT FOUNDATION of Romans 1-11.)


[#1 – Focusing on GOD'S SOVEREIGNTY.]

This ability to do the will of God was made possible by God himself! Romans 7-8 show us:

✓ Our complete inability – when relying on our own power.
✓ Our complete ability – when controlled by the Spirit of God!

Offering yourself to God, with a willingness to do his will... THIS WILL RESULT IN:


ACTION

• You will use your abilities for the good of others – Romans 12:3-8. (The focus here is on interacting with other Christians.)

LOVE

• You will do all things with unhypocritical, sincere love – Romans 12:9-21. (The focus here expands to all people.)

LOVE IN TWO

Paul focuses on some specific issues related to love.

- 1. Our relationship to government chapter 13. (It has a God-given purpose; even though it may sometimes be the cause of the injustice mentioned in Romans 12:19-20).
- 2. Our relationship to weaker, "newborn" Christians chapters 14-15a.

(These people are working on developing "renewed" minds – Romans 12:2 – but they aren't there yet.)

In the middle of these difficult issues, Paul reminds us:



This LOVE is our #1 "debt" to all people.



Let no debt remain outstanding, except the continuing debt to love one another, for he who loves his fellowman has fulfilled the law.

Romans 13:8 (NIV)

LOVE: This is a debt we will <u>never</u> cease to have.




We have learned about unhypocritical, sincere love in Romans 12:9-21.

LOVE - OUR ETERNAL DEBT

— A DEBT that's *impossible* to pay off!

Our main emphasis here is on love for *people;* but love for *God* is also part of our eternal debt - Matthew 22:37-40; Mark 12:29-31. (Only a few verses related to love for God are included.)

THIS OBLIGATION IS NOTHING NEW... YET IT IS NEW!

It's *not* a new command!

- It was taught in the Old Testament Leviticus 19:18b; and was known by the Jews in Jesus' day Mark 12:32-33; Luke 10:27.
- Jesus taught it Matthew 19:17-19.
- It's a command that the people tended to distort (as people do today); and Jesus had to clarify what it meant - Matthew 5:43-48; see also Luke 10:29-37.

Yet Jesus gives it to us as a new command!

- We have a *new motivation* for doing it: We are to love others as *Jesus* loved us, not just love others "as *ourselves*" John 13:34; 15:12, 17; 1 John 3:16; 4:11 (as *God* loved us).
- We have a new power to do it, power from God 1 John 4:7-12; also Galatians 5:22; 1 Thessalonians 3:12; 4:9; 2 Timothy 1:7. (In the Old Testament: People needed hearts changed by God, so that they would love him Deuteronomy 30:6.)

- This love is evidence that we are part of a *new family*, the family of God John 13:35; 1 John 3:11-15, 17-19; 4:7b, 12.
- Scripture gives us no additional "new" command that goes beyond Jesus' "new" command - 1 John 3:11, 23; 2 John 1:5; see also 1 John 2:7-8.

This obligation is for *all* people.

The sinful nature prevents unsaved people from fulfilling it.

ABOUT THIS OBLIGATION TO LOVE

- The Old Testament Law is summarized by love, and is fulfilled by love Matthew 22:40; Galatians 5:13-14; James 2:8-11; Romans 13:9-10 (it does nothing contrary to the moral law).
- Our obedience to Jesus is evidence that we love Jesus John 14:15; see also 1 John 5:3-4 (love for God).
- If this love is in us, we won't be preoccupied with the sins of others - 1 Peter 4:8. (Love forgives and doesn't focus on the sin.)
- Love begins in our Christian family; but it is to extend out to all people 1 John 4:11, 19-21; Romans 12:9-21; Ephesians 4:2-3; 1 Thessalonians 3:12.
- Our love must grow in intensity, and God makes it possible -1 Peter 1:22 (it's growth is associated with obeying God's truth); 1 Thessalonians 3:12; 4:9-10.
- We must encourage each other to grow in love Hebrews 10:24; 1 Thessalonians 4:10b.
- When love grows within our Christian family, we can thank God for it - 2 Thessalonians 1:3 (an example).
