THESE THINGS TO BECOME EXAMPLES OF SINFUL CRAVING?

- They aren't <u>always</u> sinful. (Scripture gives us examples of <u>qodly</u> people who had money, clothes and possessions.)
- But they <u>are</u> sinful when: a person desires them <u>more</u> than he desires the things of God.



There is a **BIG** difference between:

> ACCIDENTAL sin (and <u>repenting</u> of it), and > DELIBERATE sin (and <u>NOT repenting</u> of it; and often not admitting it is sin).

But when people keep on sinning, it shows they belong to the Devil, who has been sinning since the beginning.

Those who have been born into God's family do not sin, because God's life is in them. So they can't keep on sinning, because they have been born of God.

We know that those who have become part of God's family do not make a practice of sinning, for God's Son holds them securely, and the evil one cannot get his hands on them.

1 John 3:8a, 9; 5:18 (NLT)

✓ Since we <u>cannot</u> <u>serve</u> <u>both</u> <u>GOD</u> <u>and</u> <u>WEALTH</u>, our ONLY <u>non-sinful</u> option is to <u>REPENT</u> every time we discover we've put "<u>things</u>" ahead of <u>God</u>.

ACCORDING TO JESUS:

"No one can serve two masters. He will hate the first master and love the second, or he will be devoted to the first and despise the second. You cannot serve God and wealth."

Matthew 6:24 (GW)

Do you think there's an "exception" to this warning? Focus on the highlighted words in the above verse.

✓ If we choose to focus on "things," instead of God, it means we have chosen to live like a godless person!

ACCORDING TO JESUS:

"So don't worry about having enough food or drink or clothing.

Why be like the pagans who are so deeply concerned about these things?

Your heavenly Father already knows all your needs, and he will give you all you need from day to day if you live for him and make the Kingdom of God your primary concern.

Matthew 6:31-33 (NLT)

THIS WEEK:

Consider how much focus you have on wealth, money, possessions, etc.

Compare that to your focus on GOD.

Who are you actually serving?
