


CRAVING or DESIRING something can be
1) good, 2) evil, or
3) determined by other factors.



- ✓ ALWAYS Sinful and evil this is a killer sin
- ✓ Must first evaluate other factors THE CONTEXT in which it occurs.
- ✓ ALWAYS Righteous and good this is NOT a sin.





 CRAVING MEAT could be a <u>SIN:</u>

... and the people of Israel also began to complain. "Oh, for some meat!" they exclaimed.

Numbers 11:4b (NLT)

**CONTEXT**: Questioning God's power, ungrateful for his provisions, putting him to the test, etc.


 CRAVING MEAT could be a RIGHTEOUS ACT:

You may eat as many animals as the Lord your God gives you.

... you may eat meat whenever you want.

Deut. 12:15b, 20b (NLT)

**CONTEXT**: Rejoicing in God's provisions, his fulfilled promises, etc.





Normally, it's a very good thing!

For wisdom is far more valuable than rubies.
Nothing you desire can be compared with it.

Proverbs 8:11 (NLT)

It's the moral fool who doesn't want wisdom!

It is senseless to pay tuition to educate a fool who has no heart for wisdom.

Proverbs 17:16 (NLT)

When the woman saw that the tree produced fruit that was good for food, was attractive to the eye, and was desirable for making one wise, she took some of its fruit and ate it. She also gave some of it to her husband who was with her, and he ate it.

Genesis 3:6 (NET)

SATAN: "Eat it, and you'll become wise!"

EVE: "I want that wisdom, and I'm willing to sin to get it!"



Scripture often mentions the value of friendship!

But now Timothy has ... reported that you always have good memories of us, wanting to see us, as we also want to see you.

1 Thes. 3:6 (HCSB)


I long to see you so that ... you and I may be mutually encouraged by each other's faith.

Romans 1:11-12 (NIV)

A friend loves at all times, and a brother is born for adversity.

Proverbs 17:17 (NIV)

Sometimes *avoiding* people is sin! We should not stop gathering together with other believers, as some of you are doing. Instead, we must continue to encourage each other even more as we see the day of the Lord coming. Hebrews 10:25 (GW) But it's sinful to desire the company of evil people! Do not envy wicked "Bad company men, do not desire corrupts good their company; ... character." Proverbs 24:1 (NIV) 1 Cor. 15:33b (NIV)



God's people look forward to that day!

[The Lord will reward] all who eagerly look forward to his glorious return.



2 Tim. 4:8b (NLT)

But if you only want him to come so that <u>you</u> can escape your problems, and that <u>others</u> can be punished... you're in for a big surprise.



Woe to you who long for the Day of the LORD!

What will the Day of the LORD be for you?

It will be darkness and not light.

Amos 5:18 (HCSB)

These people were like the church-going fakes of today.



• God's people would like to be with Jesus even now.

(Yet they are willing to remain <u>here on earth</u> until the time GOD chooses to bring them home.)



[We] would prefer to be away from the body and at home with the Lord.

2 Corinthians 5:8b (NET)

I desire to depart and be with Christ, which is better by far; but it is more necessary for you that I remain in the body.

Philip. 1:23b-24 (NIV)

 But people often desire death for the wrong reason.



(CONTEXT: UNREPENTANT PEOPLE DURING THE END TIMES JUDGMENTS.)

At that time people will look for death and never find it. They will long to die, but death will escape them.

Rev. 9:6 (GW)

They were experiencing judgment for sin, and <u>didn't want to repent</u>.


They thought death would be a means to escape.



• It may be good for a tired worker.

The **sleep** of the laborer is pleasant—whether he eats little or much ...

Ecclesiastes 5:12 (NET)



Do not long for the cover of night to drag people away from their homes.

Job 36:20 (NET)



 The Old Testament said that signs were one of the means for verifying who was a true prophet.



You may wonder, 'How will we know whether the prophecy is from the Lord or not?'

If the prophet **predicts** something in the Lord's name and it does not happen, the Lord did not give the message. That prophet has spoken on his own and need not be feared.

Deut. 18:21-22 (NLT)

The prophet's message also had to point people to the true God – see v. 20; 13:1-5.


• But to <u>reject</u> the signs that have already been given, and to ask for *more* is a different matter!




But he replied to them, "An evil and adulterous generation craves a sign. Yet no sign will be given to it except the sign of the prophet Jonah, ...

Matthew 12:39 (ISV)

See the previous chapters.
They had already witnessed <u>many</u> signs and miracles!
