- ✓ You won't even be able to comprehend the sinfulness of your sin, without it being exposed by God's Word. You will be blind to the depths of your *slavery* to sin.



WHEN IT'S VIEWED AS MERELY "A RADICAL EXPRESSION OF RELIGION" ...

✓ Doing it may seem like a major burden... like it was for some in Israel.

And you say, 'What a burden!' and you sniff at it contemptuously," says the Lord Almighty.

✓ You will <u>never</u> be able to comprehend the freedom from sin that the "burden" of following Jesus brings.
